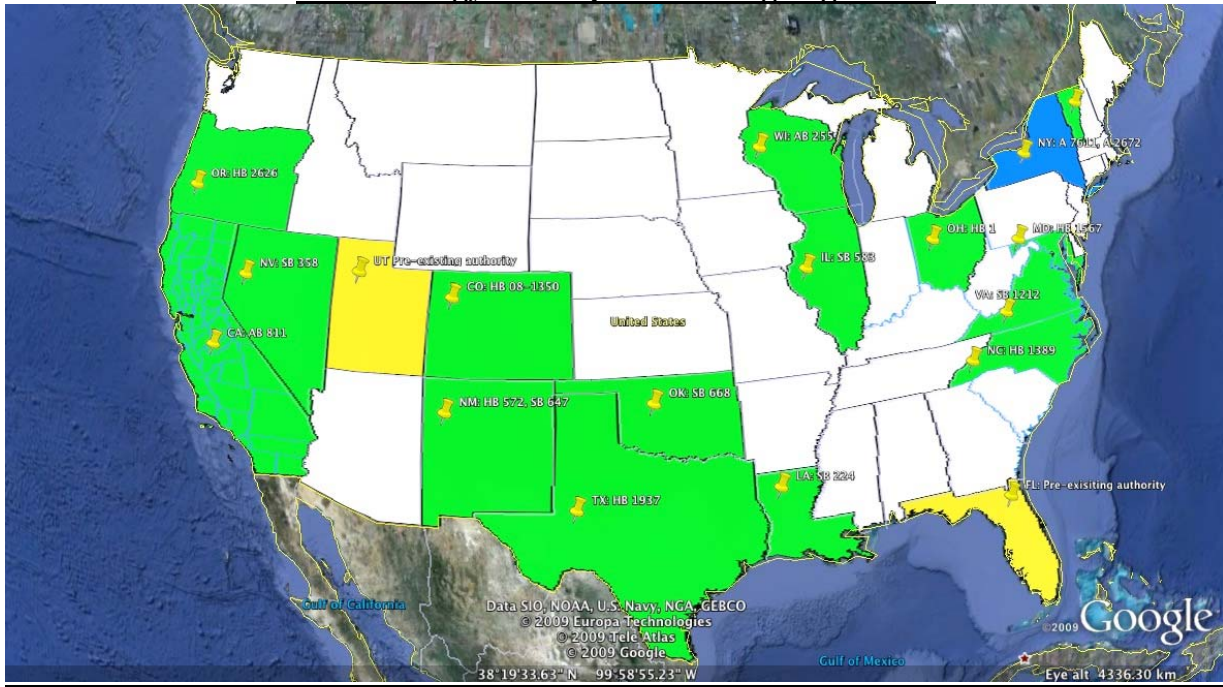


Clean Energy Municipal Financing Legislation
